Mathematics

Time – Months and years, hours in a day, telling the time to the minute, the 24hour clock, using a.m. and p.m., measuring time in seconds.

Geometry – Right angles, comparing angles, horizontal and vertical, parallel and perpendicular, 2-D and 3-D shapes.

Money – Adding money, calculating change and working through Money word problems.

Mental Mathematics strategies

Arithmetic & Reasoning questions practice.

Science

Habitats:

Living Things and Their Habitats - During this topic, the children will learn how to identify a range of British plants and animals, and how to classify organisms, including the use of classification keys. They will also consider why organisms live in different habitats and the impact, both positive and negative, that humans can have on environments.

Humanities

Geography:

This 'All around the World' Unit allows children to take a closer look at where the countries of the world are located, and some of the ways geographers describe locations. Children will learn to locate and describe places using longitude and latitude and find out about some of the important lines that delineate specific areas of the Earth - the Equator, the Hemispheres, the Poles and the Tropics.
